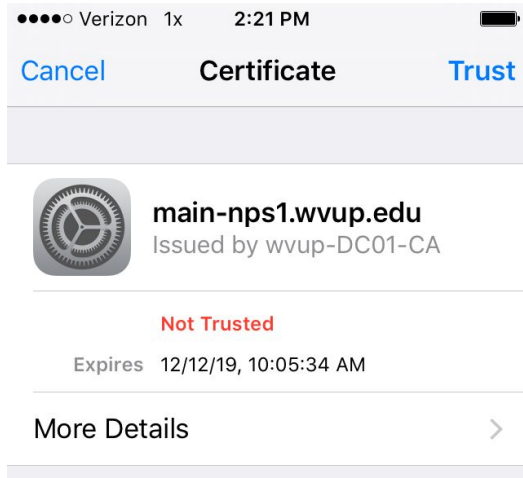


# Joining the “Students” or “Employees” Wireless Network

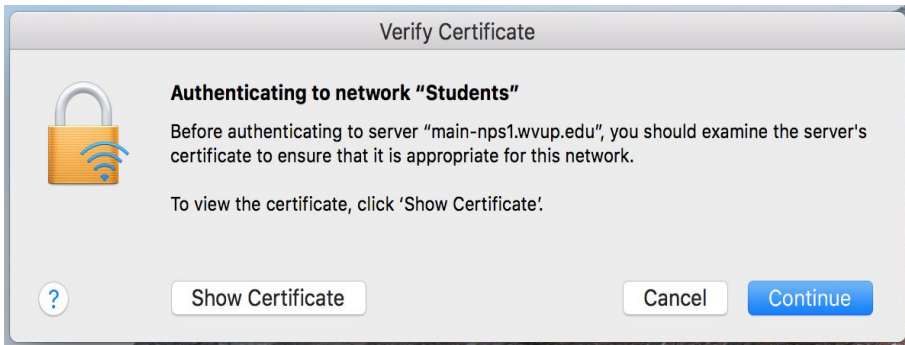
After selecting the appropriate network (“**Students**” if you’re a student, “**Employees**” if you’re a staff or faculty member), enter your WVUP network login information, and follow the instructions for your device listed below.

**Your device may be different! If so, open a ticket at [helpdesk.wvup.edu](http://helpdesk.wvup.edu) and let us know! We’ll happily help you get connected!**



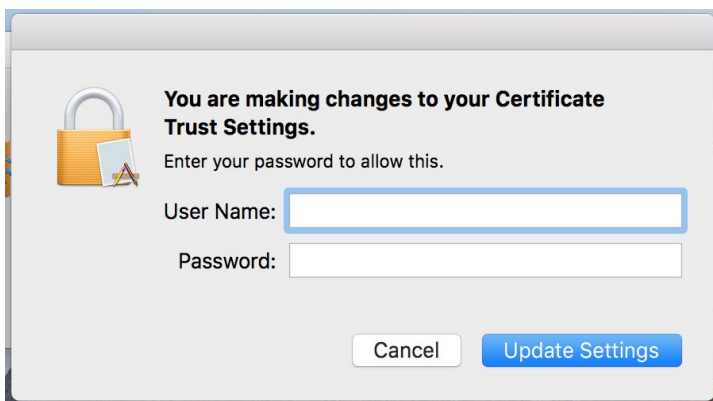
## iPhone/iPad

After selecting the network and entering your username and password, you’ll be prompted with this screen. Select “**Trust**” in the upper right corner and you will be joined to the network.



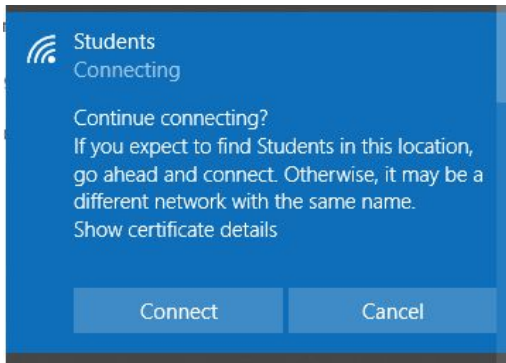
## MacBook/iMac

After selecting the network and entering your username and password, you’ll be prompted with the screen on the left. Select “**Continue**” to proceed to the next prompt.



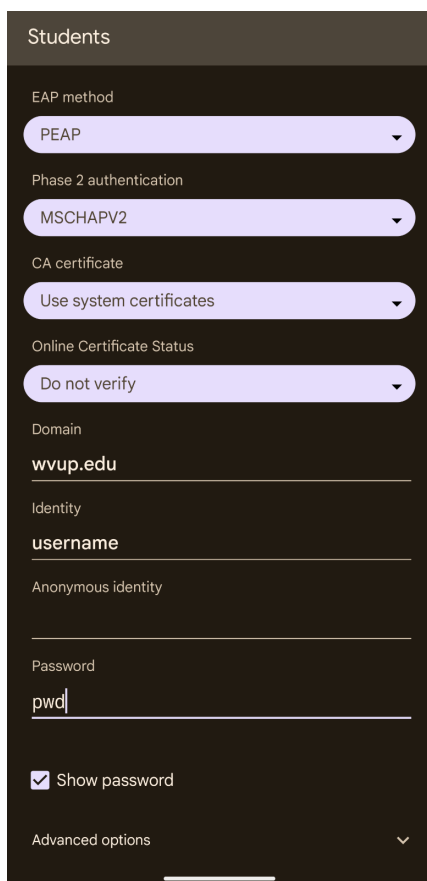
After selecting “**Continue**” above, you’ll be asked to enter the username and password that you use to login to your MacBook (**not your WVUP Network ID**) to complete the process. Select “**Update Settings**” and you will be joined to the network.

# Joining the “Students” or “Employees” Wireless Network



## Windows 10

After selecting the network and entering your username and password, you’ll be prompted with a message similar to the one in the image on the left. Select “**Connect**” and you will be joined to the network.



## Android / ChromeBook

When you select the “**Students**” or “**Employees**” network on an Android device, you may be prompted with a screen like the image to the left. Before adding your credentials, you may need to tap “**CA certificate**” to open a selection menu.

*If you do not see this option, check to see if your operating system is up to date.*

- Next, you'll see the "Select Certificate" menu.
- Choose "Use System Certificates"
- Add "wvup.edu" to the Domain field.
